

**REQUIREMENTS:**

Create (2) 11" x 17" Exterior Renderings

PROCESS:

- Step 01:** Model the site of your Wood Precedent Study using the workflow from A06
- Step 02:** Create a Rhino Model of your Wood Precedent Study and position on your site
- Step 03:** Set 2 exterior cameras for 2 different exterior views
- Step 04:** Using snapshots create custom sun/shadow conditions for each camera view
- Step 05:** Use the Rhino Renderer to export pngs of each of your views. All files should be 11" x 17" with transparent backgrounds. Shadows should be on.
- Step 06:** Using Photoshop, combine gradients, texture sketches, and manipulated images to create custom sky and ground context.
- Step 07:** Add People and Trees to your Renderings
- Step 08:** Desaturate the color of your renderings in Photoshop

If you are not in 1st year studio you can use a previous or current studio project.
