

**REQUIREMENTS:**

Produce revised versions of the following renderings of your Studio Precedent Study. Additionally, create an Interior Rendering and a 3D section perspective rendering. Make sure to incorporate your Professor's comments and critique. Be self critical of your renderings and make them the best they can possibly be.  
*(You will have four drawings in total)*

**1.) Exterior Renderings** - Produce (2) 11"x17" Exterior Renderings (A07 revised). At least one camera should be at eye level (4'-6" above ground level). The renderings must include building material textures, shadows, site model, custom backgrounds, context buildings, and scale figures.

**2.) Interior Rendering** - Produce (1) 11"x17" Interior Rendering. The rendering must depict an event taking place involving (3) or more people. The rendering must include building material textures, furniture, lighting, custom background, context, and scale figures.

**3.) 3D Section Perspective Rendering** - Produce (1) 11"x17" 3D Section Perspective rendering. Use a solid fill for all areas that the section cuts through. The rendering must include building material textures, shadows, site model, custom backgrounds (make the background almost white), context buildings, and scale figures.

## RENDERING NOTES:

- Desaturate all color, especially the background
- Backgrounds should fade away to the back, not pop forward. Your building should be the focal point.
- Google search photos of your precedent study to help you compose your renderings and give you a sense of what type of context you will need in your renderings.
- Take away some of the building skin to reveal the interior framing.
- Your 3D model should be of the entire building including all of the details. For example, if the building has a soffit cap, standing seam roofing, stairs (interior or exterior), etc.. Please model those details. Let your precedent research guide and inform you.
